



## **PADI OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE**

The PADI Open Water course certification is the first training level to discover the underwater world. During the course students get all the skills and knowledge to become a certified scuba diver, being able to dive without the supervision of a professional and having all the fundamentals to control situations practiced during the course. Course duration: 1 day theory (classroom), 3 days confined water (pool) and 4 open water dives.

### **Prerequisites**

- Minimum age 10 years old. Note: 10-14 year old divers earn a Junior Open Water Diver certification.
- Participants must complete a medical statement of health and fitness. Any participant who has a medical condition must submit a certification from a doctor clearing him/her to practice scuba diving.

### **Certification Requirements**

- Complete five knowledge development segments, including quizzes and final exam.
- Complete 5 Confined Water Dives.
- Meet water skills assessment requirements.
- Complete 4 Open Water Dives. Maximum depth 18 meters/60 feet (Junior Divers: Max. depth 12 meters/40 feet)
